The ASVAB

The ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) is a timed test that identifies areas of strength, and areas that may need improvement, but can help you learn about jobs that you may be offered if you were to enlist. The scores are in four critical areas including: Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension and Mathematics Knowledge. The total score is considered your AFQT (Armed Forces Qualifying Test). This score determines if you are qualified to enlist in the U.S. Military, which branch(es) and for which careers within the branches. There are practice tests you can take online. Some recruiters will provide the test for you or you can take the test at Pinkerton.

The ASVAB will be held here at Pinkerton Academy in the Freshman Academy Cafe on December 5th, 2019 from 12:30-4pm (an early release day.)

Your results will be available and an interpretation session will be held on January 10th, 2020 during B & C periods in the Media Center.

We will hold another exam on March 25, 2020 at 4pm if there is enough interest.
